

Dear St. Andrew's Queen of the Highlands Candidate,

Thank-you for your interest in the St. Andrew's Queen of the Highlands. We are excited to receive your information. Candidates who are females, ages 18 to 22 years as of July 1, 2010 will be considered for the 2010 Queen of the Highlands and court. A *wee bit* of Scottish descent is required for application. The Queen will receive a \$1,500 college scholarship, crown, sash and the chance to travel the state to promote the St. Andrew's Society of Detroit at various parades and events. Up to two court members will also be selected - and will each receive a \$750 and \$500 scholarship, respectively. They will also receive a crown, sash and the chance to represent the St. Andrew's Society of Detroit. To be eligible for Queen, applicant may not be present Queen or court from other organization (example: 2010 Alma Queen of Scots, 2010 National Cherry Queen, etc). Daughters or granddaughters of St. Andrew's Society Executive Board, Trustees, Games Chairmen and Queen Directors are not eligible to apply. Please return completed application to:

Application information must all be sent in one envelope postmarked by March 3, 2010 to be considered. From the applications received, we will select five finalists to attend an interview on Saturday, April 10, 2010 in Shelby Township. The crowing of our queen and court will be later that evening at the Tartan Day Ceilidh in Troy, MI. Family and friends are welcome to purchase tickets to attend the evenings festivities. The finalists will need to be available for all of these events. A detailed list of duties and expectations will be provided at the crowning.
